RULES FOR THE ADMISSION OF FOREIGN CITIZENS TO PANEVĖŽIO KOLEGIJA/ STATE HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTION IN 2025

1. The Rules for the Admission of Foreign Citizens to Panevėžio kolegija/ State Higher Education Institution in 2026 (hereinafter referred to as the Rules for the Admission of Foreign Citizens) establish the principles for calculating the competitive score and other selection criteria for the admission of citizens of the Member States of the European Union, the European Economic Area, other foreign countries and stateless persons (hereinafter referred to as foreigners) who do not participate in the admission conducted by LAMA BPO to Panevėžio kolegija/ State Higher Education Institution (hereinafter referred to as the College) in 2026.

2. The general principles and procedure for the admission of foreigners are established in the Description of the Procedure for the Admission of Foreign Citizens to Panevėžys College.

3. Study programs and forms to which foreigners are admitted in 2026 are presented in Table 1.

5. Admission of foreigners is usually carried out by June 1.

6. The Coordinator of International Studies checks and assesses the applicant's suitability to study the desired study programme based on the submitted documents.

7. At the initial stage of the application assessment, the applicant's readiness for studies and compliance with the main requirements are assessed: English language proficiency level (not lower than B2 level), results of acquired education and learning achievements (not lower than the one specified in the SKVC general recommendations or not less than 60 percent overall grade point average) and other criteria, if such are specified in the academic recognition requirements for foreign citizens.

8. If the applicant meets the main requirements, the candidate's competitive score is calculated. The minimum entrance competitive score for admission of foreigners is 4. The structure of the competitive score depends on the chosen study programme.

9. The entrance competitive score is calculated using the formula below, i.e. by multiplying the standardized grades of individual subjects by the weighted coefficient and summing them:

$$SKB = 5 \times \frac{PV}{V_{max}} + 2,5 \times \frac{AV}{V_{max}} + 2,5 \times \frac{TV}{V_{max}}$$

where SKB is the entrance competitive score, PV , AV , TV are the grades of the first, second, and third subject, respectively, V_{max} is the maximum possible grade.

10. When the number of applicants is greater than the maximum number of places in a particular study program, the admission of foreigners is carried out on a competitive basis.

11. All issues not covered by these Rules for the Admission of Foreigners are decided by the Director of the College.
